
Park Facilities

Homing Park is a member of the Premier Park Scheme and boasts an excellent award winning toilet, shower and facilities block - always ready for you when you come home from a day at the beach, a countryside hike or exploring wider Kent's towns and cities.



The pool is located right next to the clubhouse too - so you can enjoy a refreshing drink or a tasty snack at the same time as taking a dip!

There is no shop on site but there is a great local Co-op only eight minutes walk down the road.



The park also benefits from a tennis court*, a five-a-side pitch, a playground and a clubhouse with swimming pool*.

The playground is safe and secure for little adventurers and the pool is generally open between May and September, although during some of that time only at weekends.

The purchase of a new holiday home typically includes*:

- Any extras of your choosing from the manufacturer (e.g central heating, integrated appliances, fabric colours)
- Delivery from the factory
- Siting and connection to services
- Gas installation with storage box
- Veranda steps
- The remainder of the year's pitch fees (when purchased after July)

In addition to the purchase price, you'll need to budget for furnishing your holiday home, including items like crockery, bedding and electrical appliances (e.g., TV, kettle, toaster). Pre-owned caravans (typically those already sited) often come with a TV aerial left by the previous owner, but for new caravans this will need to be factored into your budget. Also, remember to plan for insurance coverage.

Camping at Homing Park



What's included

- Unlimited free use of our Platinum award loos & showers supplied with plenty hot water & hair dryers.
- Free electric hook-up (10 amp supply).
- Pitch your awning for free.
- Free water connection on every pitch.
- Friendly dogs come free (but must be kept on a lead).
- Prices are per pitch per night for up to four people and one car.
- Grey Waste.

Some Important Notes

- For your safety cycling, skateboarding, scooters etc, are forbidden.
- We have a 10mph speed limit on the park.
- Commercial or sign-written vehicles are not allowed on the park. Sorry.
- On Bank Holiday weekends there is a minimum booking of 3 nights one of which must be Saturday.
- Gazebos (strictly open sided only) are limited to a max of 3m x 3m, these are £5.00/ night - if yours is bigger than this you will be instructed to dismantle it and asked to pay for an additional pitch to put it on.
- We do not have a shop on site, however there is a great local Co-op about eight minutes walk down the road.
- Day visitors must check in & out at reception, pay a £4.00/person entry charge, and must leave the park by 9:00pm.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead and must not be allowed to disturb others.
- For our disabled facilities you'll need to bring your RADAR key.
- There is a freezer in reception for your ice packs (no food items though please).

Facilities include a tennis court*, laundry*, a five-a-side pitch and a children's playground. The clubhouse and swimming pool* are open at busy times and often have entertainment at weekends during the holidays.

Generally the pool is open between May and September, although during some of that time only at weekends (*charges apply).

Useful info and tips!



 Don't forget to bring your extension lead with a three round pin plug to connect to the free electric hook-up.

 We are unable to accept tents larger than 7 metres long or 5 metres wide or greater than 8 berths.

 Each pitch has its own electricity (10 amps) and water supply and grey water drainage point.

 On Bank Holiday weekends there is a minimum booking of three nights one of which must be Saturday and charges are per pitch, for one tourer or tent or motorhome etc (not pods) for up to four persons and one car.

 Please note that only one tent/tourer/motorhome is allowed per pitch. If you want to put up an additional tent it will need to be booked on a separate pitch.

EV CHARGING POINTS

Homing Park is equipped for electric cars with three EV Charging units. These are operational by tokens which can be purchased from Reception. The EV Charging points are located behind Reception.





Camping Pods - Camping Without the Compromises!

Do you still like the outdoorsy experience but are looking for something a little more weather-proof and secure? If so, our wooden camping pods may just be the pitch you're looking for!

Imagine all the joys of camping without the hassle. Our pods give you the outdoor adventure you crave, minus the less favorable parts of a weekend away.

While you'll still bring your camp beds, sleeping bags, and cooking gear (everything except the tent, really), you can say goodbye to:

- Listening to snoring from the neighboring tent.
- Worrying about the safety of your belongings (each pod has a lockable door).
- Unpacking a damp tent when you get home.

Our cozy pods are designed for comfort:

- The **Regular Pods** comfortably sleep up to 4 people (even more with young kids).
- The **Family Pod** has room for 6 classy campers.

Enjoy your camping getaway—simplified, secure, and stress-free.

All bookings must be for a minimum of 2 nights and 3 nights on Bank Holiday weekends (one of which must be Saturday).

Prices (see tariff on the back page) are per pod per night for pod occupants and one car. If you want to put up a gazebo it must be less than 3m by 3m, open on all sides, and you must pay the £5/night charge.

What's in the pods?

-  Half-glazed lockable doors for security and weather proofing.
-  A high level rear window for light and ventilation.
-  Two double plug sockets with USB charging points.
-  Internal dimmable spot-lights.
-  An external light on the veranda.



What's NOT in the pods?

-  There isn't a fridge or a cooker, so you'll still need to bring your own.
-  There are no beds or chairs (so remember the camp-bed or inflatable mattress and camp chairs!).
-  There is a freezer in reception for your ice packs (no food items though please).



Other useful info and tips!



- Please note there is no smoking or cooking allowed in the pods.
- BBQ's and camping stoves are allowed, but not inside the pods or on the wooden verandas and please keep them raised up off the grass too.
- A returnable £20 cash deposit is required for your key. Please have this ready on arrival.
- Pets are only permitted at the discretion of the manager and we regret no single-sex groups, or groups of under 21's are allowed.
- For your safety cycling, skateboarding, scooters etc are forbidden.
- We have a 10mph speed limit on the park.
- Commercial or sign-written vehicles are not allowed on the park. Sorry.
- For our disabled facilities in the shower block you will need to bring your RADAR key.

We look forward to welcoming you to our park. May all that arrive as guests, leave as friends.



Quex Holiday Park is partly wooded and is surrounded by countryside. Just a 3-mile drive takes you to the sandy beaches of Margate.




